The Inaugural meeting to establish the South East Asian Federation of Critical Care Nurses (SEAFCCN) was held on the 26 February, 2018 in Manila, Philippines during the 1st ASEAN Critical Care Nursing Forum organized by the Critical Care Nurses Association of the Philippines, Inc. ASEAN country representatives from Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, and the Philippines were present to establish the SEAFCCN. Professor Ged Williams (Past President of the World Federation of Critical Care Nurses) gave an inspirational message and each country representative provided information about their own critical care association or initiatives. The establishment was witnessed by the Chairman of the Philippine Regulation Commission, Honorable Glenda Arquiza, who wholeheartedly supported this newly established Federation.

The first SEAFCCN council meeting will be held in Sarawak later this year followed by Singapore in 2019 during the ICN Congress.
